The idea of mentoring someone can strike fear into the most confident heart. We tend to think that mentors need to know all the answers and have their lives completely straightened out. After all, wasn't Jesus the model mentor? You won't find any flaws there. And if that's the standard, well, we don't blame you for feeling like you don't measure up. None of us would.

But can I give you some good news?

You don't need to be perfect to be a perfect mentor.

You just need to be willing to relationally invest in someone else to help them become a more deeply devoted Jesus-follower.

Why mentoring is important

"More and Better Jesus-Followers" is more than a catchy phrase, it summarizes what Jesus has commanded the Church to do. But this mission isn't just for a select group of individuals in the Church—every Jesus-follower is called to the task of helping others to grow in their walk with God. God has equipped you with the gifts and relationships that make you uniquely suited for this task. This mission matters, and you are a vital part of it.

At Berean, one of the simplest ways that you can engage in this mission is by taking someone else through a step of the growth process.

The best mentors have 3 characteristics. They're:

FAITHFUL Are you dependable? Are you able to keep a commitment?

AVAILABLE Do you have the margin to make an intentional spiritual investment in someone else for an agreed-upon period of time?

TEACHABLE Are you willing to admit that you don't have all the answers? Are you willing to explore them?

If your answer to those questions is YES, you're the stuff that excellent mentors are made of.

We expect mentors to do 3 things:

- SHOW UP. Honor your commitment to your friend by showing up on time and ready to fully engage with them.
- BE PREPARED. Spend time each week getting to know the material so that you can guide your friend through the lesson effectively.
- HAVE FUN.

 Mentoring is fundamentally relational.

 Don't spend all of your time guiding your friend through the lesson. Take time to have fun, get to know each other, and make it enjoyable.
