



**Series Summary:** The way to have a great marriage is by not focusing on marriage.

**Sermon summary:** When two imperfect people get together, why do we expect a perfect marriage? God uses the hard times of marriage (and the hard times of relationships) to change our mindset through humility.

**Big Idea:** Marriage is a laboratory for moving from selfish to selfless.
